



Club Boat Use, Regatta, and Coaching Policy

Club Boat Use

- All use of club-owned boats and equipment must be authorized in advance by the Sailing Director or General Manager
- Club-owned gear should never be taken home unless prior arrangements are made
- Any damage incurred to boats or equipment without a coach present is the sole liability of the user
 - Liability will be assessed at the discretion of the coach for damage incurred during club-supported events

Regattas

- Sailor must be registered for the event prior to requesting a club boat
- Boats will be assigned first come, first served among registered competitors with regard to membership status
 1. Flag Member
 2. Junior Member
 3. Non-member
- Each sailor is responsible for their own boat and equipment throughout the entire event
- Boats must be unloaded and equipment must be returned immediately after the event
- All club boats must compete under the BCYC burgee, which includes dual burgee

Coaching

- 3 or more boats must be entered for BCYC to provide a coach
- Regatta fees (intended to offset regatta-related expenses incurred by the junior program)
 - Members: \$20/day
 - Non-members: \$30/day
- Weekly BBF regattas during the summer program are excluded
