PLEASE INITIAL

- _____ H20 Charter Checklist must be completed before and after each use
- _____ The mainsail must only be raised or lowered when the boat is head to wind and must be properly flaked when the sail is down
- _____ I will cleat a jib winger AT MY OWN RISK – gybing the jib with a winger cleated can cause serious damage. Jib wingers can only move the jib boom from the centerline outwards (not from one side to another)
- _____ Dock lines must be secured using a proper cleat hitch and kept with the boat at all times
- _____ The battery switch must be on “ALL” for the motor to work and must be left on “2” when not using the motor
- _____ From a dead stop, the motor will turn the boat to port (because the rudder does not work when the boat is not moving)
- _____ The motor must be rinsed with fresh water after use
- _____ The boat must be left clean

CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Independently rig the boat
- Properly tie a bowline
- Properly tie a cleat hitch
- Successfully leave the dock
- Identify & demonstrate the three basic points of sail
- Tack & gybe on command
- Start & stop on command
- Maintain a close-hauled course
- Basic understanding of Part 2 of the RRS
- Demonstrate proper use of the electric motor
- Successfully approach the dock
- Independently de-rig the boat
